Frequently Asked Question's

1. Who will make my travel arrangements?

- All candidates are responsible for their own travel.

2. Who will pay for my medical insurance during training?

- Medical insurance for the stay at Gondia is highly recommended and it should be borne by the student.

3. Where will I stay during training and who will arrange it?

- Cadets will stay within the campus during the CPL training.
- Cadets to arrange their own accommodation as per their convenience and preference. CAE can assist in sharing the CAE preferred/tied up accommodation list for Type Rating.

4. Who will arrange my visa for training (if applicable)?

- CAE will facilitate the Visa process for you, but you will be responsible to obtain a visa at your own cost & other necessary travel related documents.

5. How long is the Programme?

- We can provide link of the course duration.

6. Who will meet me on arrival at CAE's Aviation Academy in Gondia?

- A student counselor in Gondia will coordinate arrival schedules and transportation.

7. How much is the application and assessment fee?

- Application & Registration fee is INR 2500/*.
- Assessment fee is USD 400* (Exclusive of taxes) Note-Subject to change.

9. Is there any paperwork that I need to sign with IndiGo?

- 12th Mark sheet (With Math, Physics & English as subjects)
- Graduation Mark sheet for Graduates BE / B. Tech / BSC (Math, Physics, English)
- Medicals (Minimum class II medical assessment certificate issued by DGCA or class II CA form 35 issued by DGCA approved doctor)
- Resume
- ID/ Address Proof (Aadhar Card & Passport Copy)
- Registration Amount Receipt
- Application Forms (Soft Copy)
